

# INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF MAR DEL PLATA FACULTY OF HUMANITIES

The Faculty of Humanities offers 18 undergraduate and 6 postgraduate majors, with a total of 3700 active students and 130 graduates per year. The training of graduates for intermediate teaching, especially in history, geography, literature, philosophy and English, as well as the preparation for research and professional practice, especially in sociology, political science, information science and education, is highlighted. The Faculty has important developments in research and postgraduate studies, with almost one third of its teachers with a doctorate degree and a large number of publications. About 5% of its teachers carry out some international mobility every year, and about a dozen foreign teachers and researchers visit our Faculty. The Faculty intends to continue training teachers and researchers to contribute to secondary education, research, transfer, extension and public and private activity in which graduates with high level in their academic education are inserted.

#### **RESEARCH LINES**

The Faculty of Humanities has a double dependency institute UNMDP-CONICET (Institute of Humanities and Social Sciences), which brings together seven research centers in different disciplinary fields: Hispanic Literature Center (CeLeHis), Historical Studies Center (CEHis), the Buenos Aires Regional Archeology Laboratory (LARBO), the Multidisciplinary Research in Education Center (CIMED), the Social and Political Studies Center (CESP), the Studies in Information Sciences and Documentation Center (CECID), and the Geographical and Socioenvironmental Research Center for(CIGSA).

In the Faculty there are currently 362 teacher-researchers categorized in the Incentive Program, 42 members of the researcher career of CONICET, 48 fellows from CONICET and 30 fellows from the UNMDP. Each year, students from the programs of the CIN and the CIC of the Province of Buenos Aires are also added. These researchers and scholars, who are joined by uncategorized teachers, graduates and students, are currently developing 81 projects of the Program of the National University of Mar del Plata. In addition, a dozen projects of the National Agency for the Promotion of Science and Technology and of the National Council of Scientific and Technical Research, as well as international projects (ECOS, RISE, etc.) are being executed or have recently been executed.



The main fields of research are: gender, education, new information and communication technologies, information systems and database management, social structure, poverty, social movements, social conflict, labor studies, social economy, national policy, public policies, violence and security, human rights, memory, Argentine, Latin American and world history, territorial planning, urban and rural spaces, fruit and vegetable production, environment, housing, living conditions, population, archeology, linguistics and applied linguistics, education of languages, Argentine and Latin American literature, European literature, American history and literature, analytical philosophy, contemporary philosophy, ethics, aesthetics, political theory.

# **EXTENSION LINES**

Gender and Diversity. An active part was taken in the coordination of the activities of March 8 for the International Working Women's Day and the International Women's Strike, with the support of the Academic Unit. The Extension Seminar, "Gender and Libraries", was held at Casa del Balcón, coordinated by Dr. Laura Andrade and Dr. Sergio Aguirre. The Seminar offered in the Sociology course "Revolutions: Social Theory and Feminist Thought" was delivered as an Extension Course, and was given by the Study Group "Family, Gender and Subjectivities" of the Faculty of Humanities of the UNMDP. Together with the Student Center, the activity "Gender stereotypes in children's literature" was carried out, with the participation of Dr. Cecilia Rustoyburu and Emiliano Saá, illustrator of Editorial Chirimbote and the Antiprincesses Collection .The Secretary of Extension integrates the institutional representation in the Commission on Gender Protocol of the UNMDP and participates in all its instances.

Popular Education. Based on the demand of civil society organizations, the Secretary of Extension of the Faculty of Humanities, the Department of Educational Sciences and the Student Center, constitute a long-term device for the articulation of training proposals and Participation aimed at strengthening the link between the Faculty of Humanities, non-formal educational spaces and schools referenced in critical pedagogy, and promoting a pedagogical training situated, inclusive and critical that enriches the educational trajectory of the subjects involved in the concrete educational act . A specific training path is carried out, coordinated by teachers from the Department of Educational Sciences, called "Ateneos en Educación Popular".

Reading Points in Cultural Bars. This initiative generates informal and thematic reading spaces in the bars, framed in the Program of Promotion of Cultural Bars of the Secretary of Culture of the City Hall of General Pueyrredón. It seeks to promote the meeting and dissemination of local culture and literature, through the recognition and signpost emblematic cultural spaces of our community.



Open Chair of Palestinian Studies "Edward Said". With the sponsorship of the Free Chair of Palestinian Studies "Edward Said" of the Faculty of Philosophy and Literature of the UBA, meetings were held on the problems in the Middle East. These activities have a continuous character

Human Rights. Regularization actions were planned for the Human Rights Observatory of the Faculty of Humanities, with a view to strengthening a long-term agenda. Within this framework, and together with ADUM and the Student Center, a commemorative activity was held on May 8, called "Institutional Violence: legacies of the past, challenges of the present", with the presence of university researchers and organizations of Memory and Human Rights. In turn, during the week of the CRES, the Secretary of Extension held a meeting with his counterpart from the Faculty of Philosophy and Humanities of the National University of Córdoba and with members of the Provincial Memory Commission, and agreed to work together in 2019 due to the 50th Anniversary of the Cordobazo. The Observatory developed various activities during the last year.

Socio Community Practices. The Secretary accompanied the inauguration of the Seminar on Socio-Community Practices, dictated by the Department of Information Science. The dissemination and participation in the Teacher Training Course "Socio Community Practices: linkage between teaching and extension", provided by ADUM and SEU, is articulated.

#### TRANSFER AND LINKAGE LINES

The UNMDP has been developing policies and implementing concrete actions in innovation, promoting the transfer of research results and knowledge generated in the different spaces, as a key input that aims to promote its application for regional and local development. In line with this development, the Faculty of Humanities intends to create the Area of Innovation and Knowledge Transfer (I + T) in order to provide a space for the generation of discussion areas and action plans for the consolidation of the transfer of knowledge in the Humanities and Social Sciences. This area is aimed at strengthening institutional capacities for the transfer of research results, as a key input that aims to promote its social impact through public policy advice and its application for regional and local development. Since 2015, the Faculty of Humanities has a representative on the Board of Directors of the Business Incubator of the University. Currently, the Faculty has a technology linking project funded by the SPU in the program's call "Universities adding value". In addition, transfer agreements are developed or have been developed with public agencies and other institutions:



Training Agreement between the Faculty of Humanities and the Hunter College of the City University of New York (OCA No. 3470/16), Agreement between the Faculty of Humanities and the National Institute of Statistics and Census (OCA n° 1050/13, Agreement between the Faculty of Humanities and the Superintendence of Occupational Risks (OCA n° 2719/15), Agreement between the Faculty of Humanities and the National Ministry of Health (OCA No. 3589/15).Recently, funding has been obtained for a project within the program's call "Universities adding value", for the development of an application for the use of municipal health services.
